Minutes – February 17, 2014

Chapter President Jon Baker called the meeting to order at 6:17 PM.

Rituals were recited.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved as presented.

Janet Wagner gave the Treasurer's report, noting a balance of \$1,047.16. The report was approved.

Chapter members welcomed new members Jim and Margaret Patty, who were introduced by Sgt-at-Arms Carlos Estrada.
