Minutes – July 15, 2013

Chapter President, Jon Baker, called the meeting to order at 1815 hours at Post 694. Rituals were recited.

The minutes of the meeting of June 17, 2013 were approved as distributed.

Treasurer Janet Wagner, gave the treasurer's report, which was approved and placed on file for audit.

Vice President Gary Deaton reported on the Hollister 4<sup>th</sup> of July Rally, noting that members Ray Glass, Sophia Li, and Val Valdez had also participated.

Janet advised that the name patches should be arriving soon. She also thanked Mary Estrada, Gary Deaton, and Jon Baker for posting the Colors at the Marina Relay for Life event.

Chaplain Mary Estrada reported that she is a member of the United Veterans Council (VTC), and they have asked if one of our members would be interested in serving as a representative to that body.
